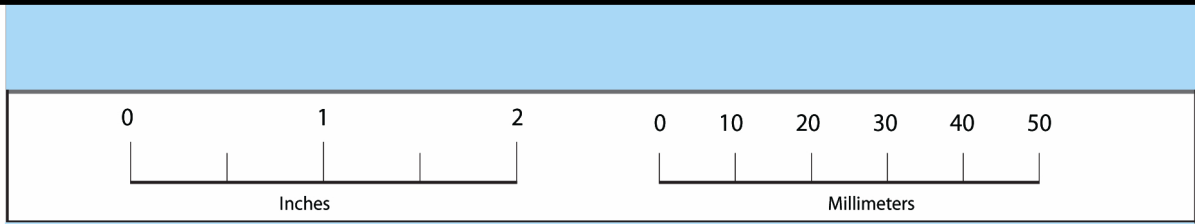


Cry for the Moon

Ring gauge guide

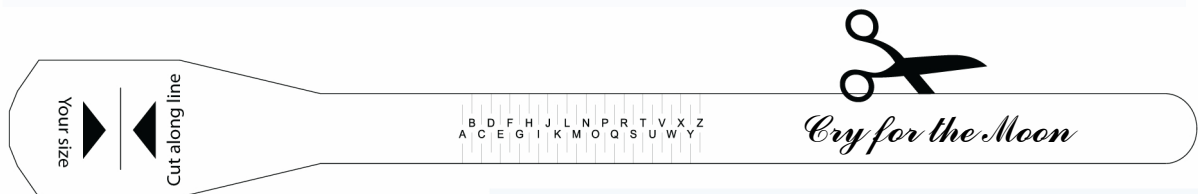


When this document is printed, you can ensure the scale by measuring the above marks with a ruler. If they match, then the document has been printed correctly and will be an accurate guide to measuring your ring size.

Printing the ring gauge

1. Cut around the edge of the ring gauge and make a slit with a sharp knife on the 'cut along line' area.
2. Make a loose circle by slipping the logo end of the gauge through the slit you have cut.
3. Tighten the gauge around your finger to read your size. Be sure not to tighten the gauge to much in fact make it a little looser than you would think to as you have to imagine being able to slide the ring size off your finger and over your knuckle.

If the reading is between sizes always go for the next size up.



We would always recommend that you have your finger measured properly so that you know the correct size by any local jeweller or call in to our store.

The above information will act as a rough guide to ring sizing when you are unsure of the size, excluding full eternity rings we can size almost all rings within a few hours subject to number of sizes and design.

Another way of checking your ring size is to take an existing ring and place on the ring sizes above to determine your correct ring size.

Make sure the circle fits snugly inside your existing ring so that the edges of the circle are touching the inside of your ring. If you're in between sizes always opt for the next size up.
